Per our notification procedures for incidents regarding harassment, unruly conduct and or violent behavior, the complainant is to be notified of developments in the investigation. This single exception is in keeping with the Reauthorization of Higher Education Act (1998) and the Student's Right to Privacy Act, as amended.

On October 25, 2017, the Office of Student Conduct received a report that you may have experienced a violation of our sexual misconduct policy. On October 26, you provided your statement regarding the report, were provided options for services and informed how our office would be proceeding.

This email is to serve as an update to your report.

- Please be advised as of Monday, November 20, 2017, the respondent associated with your report will have restricted access to your residence hall and no longer resides in Minton Hall until further notice from the Office of Student Conduct.
- As a reminder, on October 26, 2017 Office of Student Conduct issued a No Contact Order between yourself and [REDACTED]. I must remind you at this point to also not have any continued intentional contact with Mr. [REDACTED]. This includes, but is not limited to, physical contact, visitation, stalking, cyber stalking, phone calls, text messaging, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and third party communication. Failure to comply with this request may compromise the integrity of your incident report.

If you are concerned for your safety at any time, or should Mr. [REDACTED] have intentional contact with you, you are advised to contact the University Police Department at 270-745-2548 and then notify our office.

The Office of Student Conduct will be continuing this investigation at this time. However, if you have any information to provide us in regard to your case, or if any information should become available to you in the future, you are encouraged to provide that information to our office immediately. It is the responsibility of The Office of Student Conduct to investigate all reports to the extent of the information available.
